For: CHS Students, Staff, Parents, Alumni, Community members, officials, and opponents:

In accordance with the Governor's guidance, Washington State Department of Health, WIAA, and Asotin County Health District schools are allowed a maximum of 200 total people in our facilities both indoor and outdoor. With guidance outlined in Phase 2 schools must limit the number of people in attendance at home events. Clarkston has determined this and rules applied to all.

General Guidelines:

- Face masks must be worn at all times.
- Six-foot distance maintained at all times unless immediate family.
- Handwashing and Hand sanitizer recommended and made available.
- Teams will be socially distanced at courts and on fields.
- Fans will be video recorded by NFHS broadcast for contact tracing if needed.
- Attestation forms and will be done before entry.
- Separate entrances for teams and spectators.

Clarkston High has set this format up for spectator attendance including teams and essential personnel:

- Home rosters are deemed essential by coaching staff and will include coaching staff, athletes, statisticians, managers, and trainers. Teams can only bring parents if they fill a designated spot or are "other personnel".
- Other personnel will include clock operators, announcers, spotters, officials including line judges, admin staff (2-3), and media.
- Opponents' rosters are limited to the roster, admin-1, and essential personnel like statisticians and book keepers.
- Volleyball (up to 50) this number includes coaches, V, JV, F, C teams, and stats. Other personnel (up to 15) this number includes officials, clock, announcer, admin and book keeper and essential personnel like trainer and or ticket managers.
- Football (up to 75) this number includes coaching staff, student-athletes including V, JV, C, and stats. Teams can only bring in parents for essential jobs such as chains, spotters, tickets, and other essential personnel deemed necessary by the athletic department.
- Soccer (up to 40) this number includes coaching staff, student-athletes, V, JV, statisticians, and managers. Teams can only bring in parents for essential jobs deemed necessary by the athletic department.

- Cross Country – limited by the same number of 200 total for runners and workers of the meet. No crowding around start and finish lines and must maintain social distance. Runners must wear a mask and can drop gaiters after the race has started.
- Swimming is limited to the number of workers and facility they use and will be virtual meets.

Once the above numbers have been established before competition for our home contest, then the remaining number of entries for OUR home event will be opened up to the following groups as listed below. This is determined by CHS Admin team with guidance from our health district.

- Senior parents to include both sport and cheer
- Junior parents to include sport and cheer
- Opponents Senior parents – 2 per varsity Athlete
- Students for at large to fill capacity.
- Community members if needed to fill capacity.
- IF playing in two gyms the gyms will have a smaller capacity in Aux gym. Where 2 people per athlete will give names to our ticket office.

We will continue this until we fill capacity and then if someone leaves we will allow another to enter. IF we will have fewer team numbers or essential personnel, we will add to the parents and students of CHS.

We have cameras installed in the main gym and Adams Field that allows you to stream the games and view them at home. The Pixellot system is managed by the NFHS (National Federation of High Schools). Subscription options include: Monthly - \$10.99 and Yearly - \$69.99.
