SOPHOMORE AND JUNIOR STUDENTS: The PSAT/NMSQT Exam will be administered on Saturday, Oct. 13th, in the CHS T-Building from 8:00 to approximately noon. This is a SATURDAY test administration date therefore no transportation will be provided to or from the exam. Registration is limited and juniors will have preference. The cost is \$20 per exam. Juniors who qualify for free or reduced lunch may receive a fee waiver. This is the only time that PSAT/NMSQT Exam will be offered this school year. Students must sign up in the Guidance Office no later than 2:30 pm on Friday, Sept. 21st. Payment for the exams will be accepted from September 24th – 28th, but must be paid no later than Sept. 28th.
