**Students – From now until spring, you are to volunteer for ten hours and document it in your portfolio. You may choose to volunteer for five hours in the same place while doing the same thing or do your hours at two or more places. Below are many examples of some volunteer work that you can do and some instructions on what to do. Put this form in your advisory portfolio and read the instructions below:**

## ***Ten Volunteer Hours due by end of April, 2017***

1) When approaching a group, tell them you're from Clarkston High School and would like to know if they have any volunteer opportunities available for you to participate in. A suggestion would be to go with a friend so you both can get your hours in.

2) Some general rules for volunteer work would include: **you can't get paid for it, it should not benefit you, it should not be fundraising for a club, nor should it benefit an immediate family member** (i.e. babysitting for little brother or sister, selling items from school for fundraising, cleaning your room are all examples of non-volunteer work).
